Welcome to our Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is available every school day from 7.45am and runs in our Small Hall in the Infant building. It costs £3:00 per session (or £2.50 from 8am) and can be paid on the day. We are able to provide for up to 40 children from Reception to Year 6. All the children interact together, with the older ones really looking after the younger ones. It's like a lovely large family.

When the children arrive, we provide a wide range of both hot and cold breakfasts for them to choose from.

Each day there are a range of at least 6 cereals, yogurts, tinned fruit, fresh fruit, orange and apple juice, milk or water to drink. We also have toast, toasted muffins, crumpets, pancakes and sometimes bagels, all served with jam or marmite if desired.

On a weekly basis, there are baked beans, cheese, scrambled eggs or porridge available.

We also provide "free from" food for any allergies that are notified on the application form.

Once a term we have a themed breakfast, the favorite being our French theme when we have croissants with jam, cheese or ham.

After breakfast, the children are able to choose from a variety of activities such as board games, construction toys, games that promote gross motor control, sports equipment and an art/creative table is available for children to choose from too.

When weather permits the children can go outside to play in an enclosed area.

At all times your children are supervised by fully qualified staff.

Every member of staff has Food Safety and Hygiene at Level 1 or 2 and are either training for their NVQ in supporting teaching and learning or have already qualified at level 2 or 3.

At the end of the session, 8.40am the Early Years and Key Stage 1 children are walked to class by a member of staff while the KS2 children are trusted to walk to class to begin their day.

It is a very popular club and therefore "ad hoc" days are rarely available. If you do require an extra session then this needs to be notified a week before the date. Parents need to be aware that we may be at capacity and unable to award a place.
