Premier Sport are providing May Half-Term Holiday Clubs at West Borough.

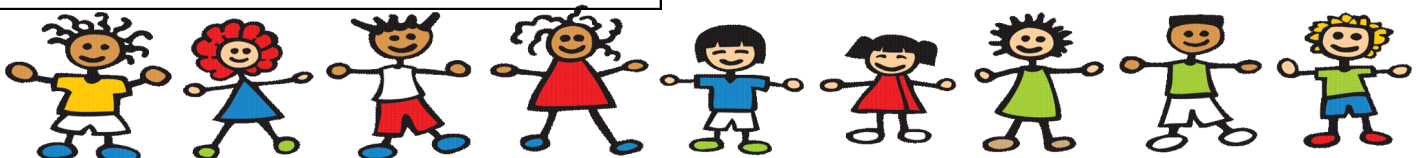
