We've also had the excitement of chicks hatching in Year R!

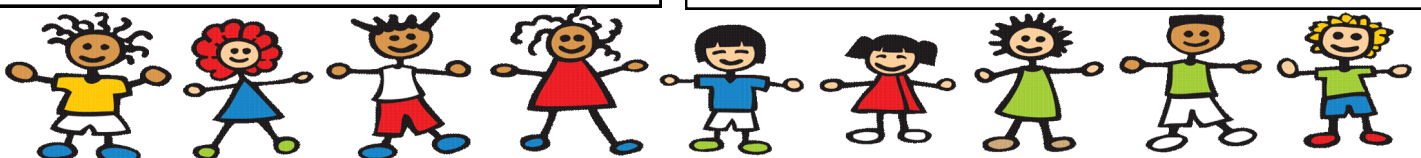


I'd also like to take this opportunity to welcome Mrs Court to our school, who will be teaching in Year 5 this term.
