**Permission to walk home alone / Mobile Phones Year 5 & 6 children only**

In the past there have been cases of children leaving the school site at home time without parental consent. Whilst we want the children to be independent in the upper school, it is of utmost importance that the children are safe and all parties know where they are.

If your child is currently in Year 5 or 6 and you would like for them to walk home by themselves, you will need to give us permission to release your child at the end of the school day.

Only children who walk home without adult supervision are allowed the use of mobile phones for safety reasons.

If any child brings a mobile phone to school without a completed permission slip the phone will be confiscated until an adult can collect it. Any child found using a phone in school will have it confiscated and a meeting will be arranged between myself, the child and their parents.

We would be grateful if you could provide us with your child's mobile phone number. Please be reassured that this information will only be used to contact pupils in an emergency and will not be shared with anybody.

Please sign, date and return Permission Slip to school as soon as possible.
