School uniform/trainers

This week there have been a number of pupils not wearing appropriate footwear to school. Our Uniform Policy states:

Footwear

The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes that have platform soles or high heels and we strongly discourage the wearing of such. Neither do we encourage the wearing of trainers to school. This type of footwear is damaging, in the long term, to growing feet and is only appropriate for sports, PE or leisurewear. Neither is it in keeping with the smart appearance of a school uniform. Children should wear black shoes or boots.



In exceptional circumstances, where your child has outgrown or damaged their shoes, please provide a note with an explanation and when you anticipate replacing them.

From September we shall not be allowing any logo-ed footwear to be worn as school shoes (e.g. Nike/Adidas)
