## Year 6 Residential - Wick Court, Gloucestershire from Friday 8<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019

We are delighted to announce our plans for the residential trip next spring. The staff will accompany the children for 7 nights (Friday to Friday) to Wick Court, where the children will experience a week in the life of a real, working farm, owned by the author Michael Morpurgo. The accommodation is an Elizabethan manor house and the trip is fully catered for. The children will get involved in all sorts of activities around the farm including:



- Feeding cows, pigs, poultry and sheep
- Feeding baby lambs and calves
- Collecting eggs
- Visiting Oldbury Dairy Farm
- Preparing and cooking meals with farm produce

The total cost for this trip including food & coach travel will be £325.00 per child which is extremely good value for money. (In comparison a PGL-type activity holiday would cost around £70.00 per night!). This can be paid in monthly instalments of £35.00 per month following your deposit. Places are limited to 36 children and we will allocate on a first come first served basis, therefore to guarantee your child's place we are asking for a £45.00 non-refundable deposit to be paid ASAP – you will then be notified in writing if your child has gained a space or not.
