#### Morning Drop-off

Just a reminder about arrangements in the mornings:

- Both gates open at 8.30am (for Years I 6 children)
- Parents/carers have the option to drop their child at one of the gates between 8.30am and 8.40am, leaving their child to walk to the playground
- If parents wish to walk children through to speak to a teacher, drop off will be from 8.40 onwards. Please keep paths and gates clear.
- Children go onto the KSI or KS2 playground, depending which year group they are in.
- Members of the Leadership Team are also happy to pass on a message or you could write in your child's reading record book
- No parents/carers are to be on the playground before 8.40am
- Each playground will be supervised from 8.30-8.40am
- The whistle will be blown at 8.40 and children will then walk to their classrooms
- The gates will to be closed and locked at 8.50am
- If it is raining, the children can shelter under the covered areas on the playgrounds.

#### Packed Lunches

If your child has a packed lunch, please ensure you pack a drink for them. This must only be water. Where possible, please make this a separate bottle to the one they have in class. Thank you.



#### Library Books

We are very lucky to have a library in school, with a librarian, Mrs Potter, who visits once a week. Children have regular sessions in the library and can bring books home. These need to be returned weekly.

Over time, some books have been lost or not returned, resulting in children no longer being able to loan books.



We would like to start the year by wiping the slate clean. This means if you've previously lost a book, you can still have a new loan. We would however, ask that where possible you replace lost books with another, either from home or a purchase at charity shop.
