Here's to a great Term 2!



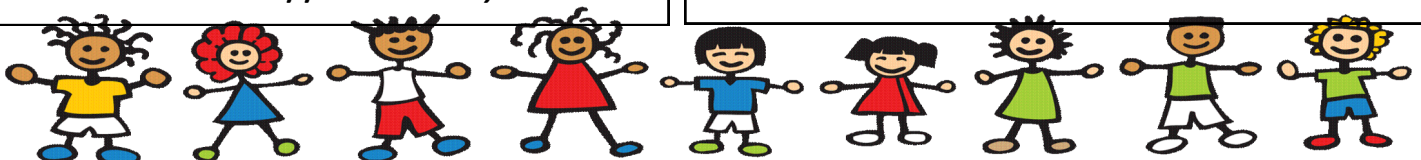
Children in Need
