One of the things that can sometimes be raised by parents

and carers is **communication** with the school.

I thought my blog was an ideal opportunity to remind you/make you aware of the many ways we communicate with families, but also what's available on our website.

We send a Newsletter fortnightly. This is an *essential* way of keeping up to date with what's going on in school and up-coming events. We won't send an individual letter every time something is happening in school. Classes no longer send home newsletters. Each class has a blog on the school website under the 'Children' section. Here you will find regular updates about what they've been up to!

Our website is a huge source of information. The calendar is kept up to date and here you can find dates for the whole year ahead. This can be accessed under the 'News and Events' section. Here you will also find copies of all letters that are sent home.

We all lead increasingly busy lives and the office will, on occasions, send text reminders for things. However, we ask that you don't rely on these and take responsibility for ensuring you're aware of events coming up in school.

community. Please can children bring items for this charity on Tuesday 10th October. Thanks.




REMINDER

Violin Lessons

"My name is Pia Alexandre and I teach stringed instruments to children in local schools. I have had a number of students here at West Borough, but now have some vacancies for anyone wishing to have violin lessons. I propose to start some group lessons; each group having a weekly lesson. The lessons will take place during the school day at a time agreed with the class teacher. There will be a cost for the group lessons and a small charge for the hire of the violin:- £24 per term for the lessons and £6 per term for the violin hire (6 terms per year).

Learning to play any musical instrument takes time and determination, but also helps young minds in many other ways - music has frequently been proven to be beneficial to our wellbeing and our thinking skills. Learning something for pleasure enables children to boost skills in other areas, and is often overlooked!

I will be in the Acorn Room (the brick building in the

playground) after school on Wednesday 18th October and will offer a short introductory session (about 20 minutes from 3:15pm) I can be contacted on 01732 840949 - please leave a
