Last year the PTFA raised £3928.02 through the disco, Secrets Room, chocolate bingo, collections and the very successful Summer Fair.

The PTFA bought the tables for the new library which cost £1499.


Every year the PTFA gives each year group £100 which helps fund class trips. A coach costs about £400 to send a whole year group on a trip.

Money has been set aside to help pay for new outside areas which are fun for play times but can also be used for outside learning. The school has been given funds to buy 20 new Chromebooks, the PTFA will be purchasing 12 more so that every child in a classroom can use one. The PTFA will also be buying two new interactive white-boards.
