### West Borough Nursery Admissions Policy

#### When can my child start?

Children are able to come to the Nursery from the age of three. Children are entitled to 15 or 30 hours of free nursery care each week from the term after they turn three (depending on eligibility). If you would like your child to attend before the funding is available, you are able to pay for sessions as soon as they turn 3, subject to availability.

We offer sessions in a flexible way between the hours of 8.35 am and 3.20pm. The free funding does not include our Lunch Club, which is chargeable at £3.00 (food not included), should you wish your child to stay for a full day. If you would like your child to have a school dinner, there is an additional charge of £2.25 per day. You are also able to 'top up' your child's sessions at the start of a new term, subject to availability and charges. The costs are as follows:

- Three hour session £15.00(8.35am-II.35am or I2.20pm-3.20pm)
- Lunch Club £3.00 (II.35am-I2.20pm) This option is only available if your child stays for a full day.

If you just wish to claim your free 15 hours then you have the option of your child attending for mornings or afternoons or a mixture of both. There are no costs attached to this option.

#### How many places are available?

There will be a maximum of 30 children in each session.

#### How are places allocated?

Your child will be added to our waiting list once an 'Expression of Interest' form has been completed. Families are invited to put their child on the waiting list at anytime before their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday, however this does not guarantee their child a place.

During the term prior to the child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday, families will receive a letter offering them a date for the child and family to visit the Nursery and meet with the Headteacher. After this initial visit, a start date will be given.

When the nursery is oversubscribed, priority is *not* given to date of application, but will be given to applications in the following order:

- I. Siblings currently attending the Nursery or school
- 2. A small number of places will be offered to children with special educational, social, emotional or medical needs
- 3. Date of birth oldest to youngest
- 4. Nearness of the child's home to the school with those children living nearer being given priority

#### **Attendance**

We believe that attending Nursery regularly is very important and helps children to feel secure and learn routines and expectations. If your child does not attend their allotted sessions regularly, it might be necessary for us to review the sessions that you have been offered so that another child can access our Nursery.
