New Sign in System

We now have an electronic system for signing in staff and visitors. This is also used where children are late to school or for early and late collection. Please ensure an adult is present to be able to sign children in or out. Thank you.

Parent Mail

You should have received an email recently to register for Parent Mail. You can also download the FREE App!

We will no longer be sending SMS text messages. Using the App, messages will be sent as emails, but you will receive a notification alert on the App (similar to a text or What's App message)

Using Parent Mail you will be able to:

- Receive messages from the school
- Complete forms and give consent electronically
- Pay for items such as uniform, trips etc
- Notify us of your child's absence
- Book appointments for our TLCs
- Keep up to date with school events

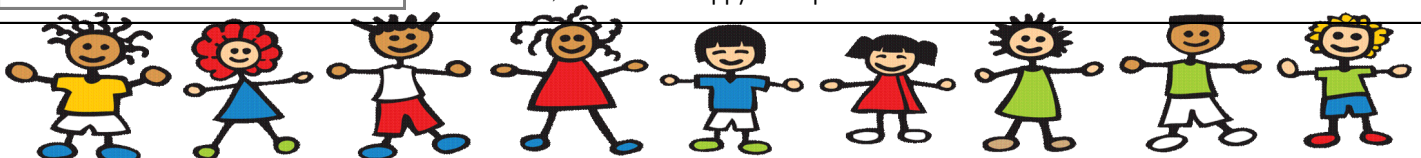

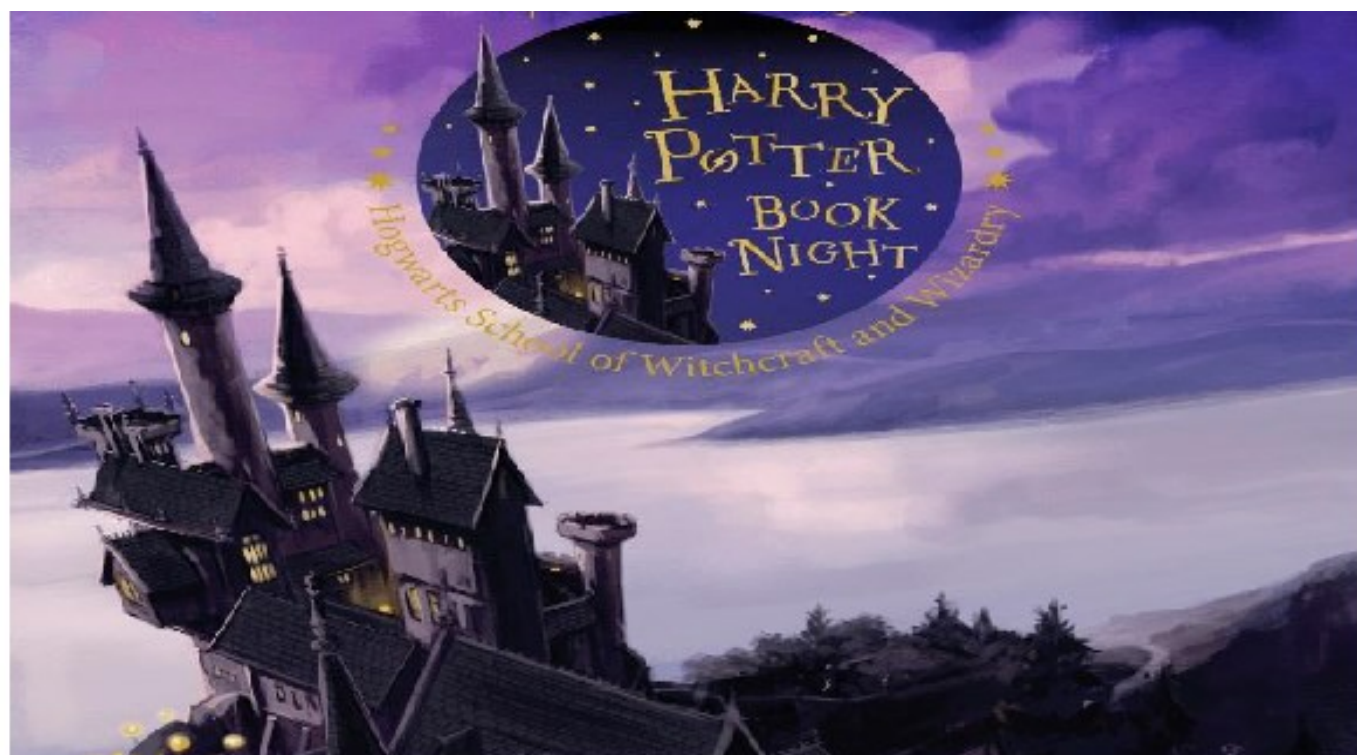
