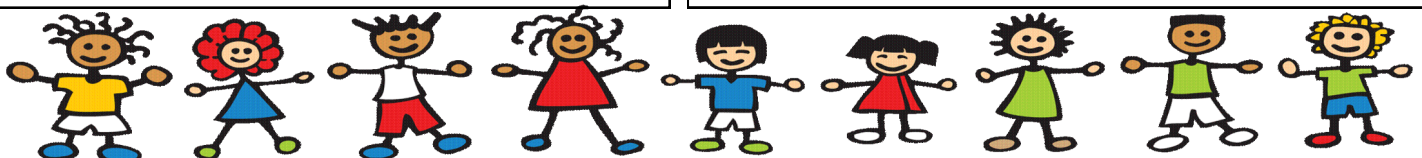
We will be saying goodbye to other children through the school who are moving on to pastures new and we wish them well too. Have a wonderful Summer!

## School Uniform

As you start shopping for next year's uniform, we'd like to take this opportunity to remind parents of our School Uniform Policy. A full copy of the policy can be found on our website, but the main points covered are below.

West Borough Primary School uniform consists of:

- White collared t-shirt, shirt or blouse
- Navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo
- Grey school trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Grey or white socks or tights
- Black shoes or boots
- House coloured round neck logo T-shirt and navy shorts for PE with suitable footwear
- Navy checked dresses for the Summer Term and Autumn Term I, grey shorts in the Summer Term and Autumn Term I

We understand that from time to time shoes get worn out or become too small or washing machines break down and it may take a few days for these to be replaced or mended. In these circumstances, please write a letter to the class teacher informing them of any non-school uniform items your child may need to wear.

Please ensure children with long hair have it tied back with suitable, small school coloured hair accessories. Earrings must be small studs and need to be removed for PE/swimming.
