This has been my second year as PTFA Chair, and I think it has been a pretty bumper year, not just in terms of the monies we have raised, which Faye will talk more about in a minute, but in terms of the members who have joined us for the first time this year, both from our new intake of reception parents but also further up the school. Having this input of help has made a huge difference to what we have been able to do, both with the number of events we have been able to run, but also how well those individual events have been organised. I feel that we have worked well together as a team, with everyone having an active role to play.

In terms of events, we had our Christmas fair in December which was very well attended and received lots of positive feedback, with several people saying it was the best they had been to, but we still have a few ideas to improve things even further. The Christmas pop-up shop was popular as always with the children, and we took the decision to not limit the number of gifts this year, which meant a huge amount of work leading up to it, but did mean a record amount raised.

We continued with the bake sales this year, which again proved successful, though we struggled at times with people available to help on the day. We also went ahead with the pamper evening that we had taken the decision to cancel the previous year, and whilst it wasn't as well attended as perhaps we'd hoped, everyone that came, including the therapists, gave good feedback and seemed to enjoy themselves. Our last big event of the year was the summer fair, which was

popular as always, and we enjoyed running some different stalls to what we have had in previous years.

This year is my final year as a parent at West Borough, and so I have decided not to stand for Chair again, instead choosing to use this year to be able to support someone else in taking over. I'd therefore like to finish by thanking everyone for all of their support in my time as Chair, and hope we can continue to build on the good work we have done over the past year.

The Year 2018/2019 was very successful year in terms of fundraising.

Christmas Fair made three times more amount of money than previous year. Barclays match fund, which Barclays pays out the same amount of money we raised at the stall, was a good additional fund for the fair. We did match fund with our tombola stall.

We also had a very successful Summer Fair, which made a £4000+ surplus and it was the highest in the last 8 years. We believe that how ruffle tickets were sold this year contributed a big surplus.

We also had the following events and all made a surplus; Tea towels, Pamper evening, Ladies gift shop (mother's day), Discos.
