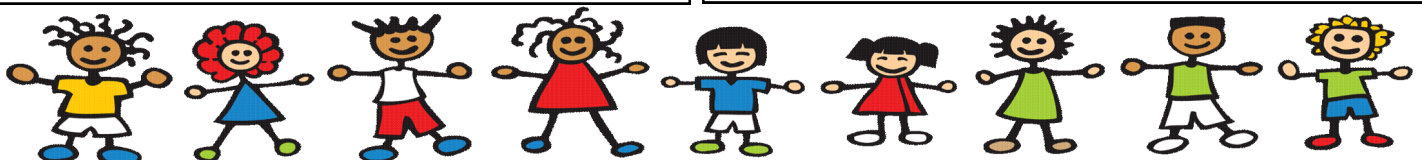

Well done to all the children who collected sponsors for this event. The NSPCC are joining us again for the assembly on Friday 13th March, when we will find out how much money has been raised.

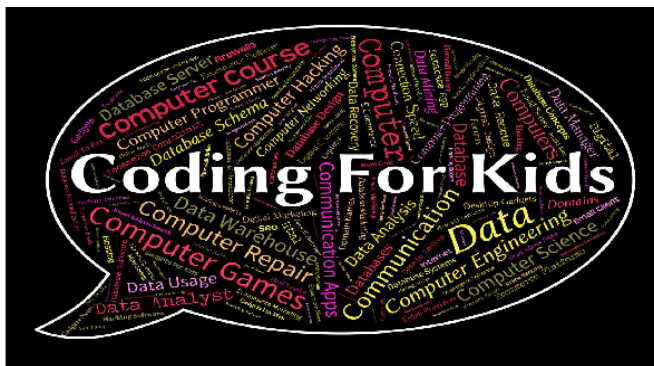

## Maidstone Code Club is back!

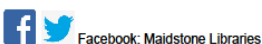
We are holding another computer coding club here in Maidstone Library!
