Hanna has been working hard on her learning every morning, and she even did Forest School building a wildlife area!

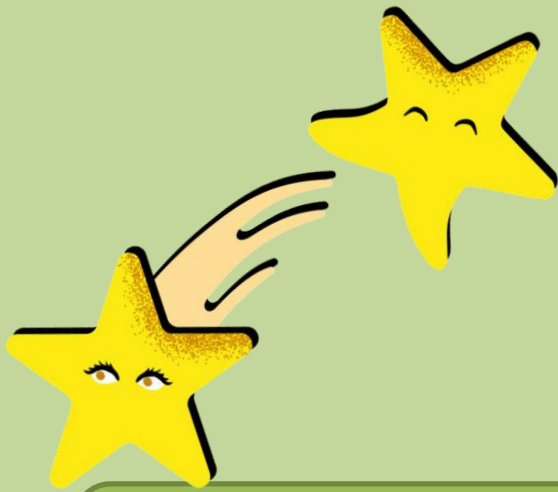
