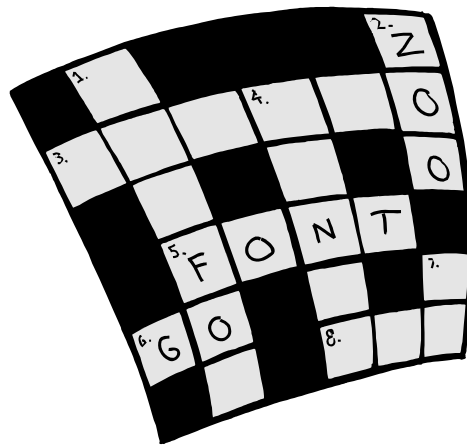


# Year 3 Spelling Crosswords and Word searches

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## Teacher's Introduction

This pack consists of over 70 word searches and crosswords to aid the teaching of spelling and literacy. All the worksheets are based on the DfES spelling bank. The worksheets can be used in the Literacy hour, given as homework or used as "early morning jobs" at the start of the school day.

Several of these worksheets come in pairs, consisting of one word search and one crossword. The crossword and the word search can be photocopied back to back. Both tasks are based around the same set of words, so the crosswords can be used for more able pupils. One suggestion is to allow pupils to do the word search first, and then match the clue with the answer.

Answers are included for all worksheets.
