




### Happy Birthday!


#### Jack D - Year 6



Thalia is being RESILIENT when she doesn't get things correct the first time, and is learning not to be so hard on her self when she makes a mistake.






#### Scarlett - Year I


### Felicity - Year R






#### **Scientist Award**
