Science Investigation 1

Materials needed:

- 4 bowls
- 4 blocks of ice
- water
- sugar
- salt

I predict that the ice in the water will melt the quickest.

Results:

	only ice:	ice + water:	ice + sugar:	ice + salt:
Time =	2hr : 30mins	1hr : 40mins	2hrs : 20mins	1hr : 40mins

I found that, the ice in water and ice on salt, melted at the same speed. Then the ice on the sugar melted 3rd, and the 4th was the ice on its own, which melted the slowest.

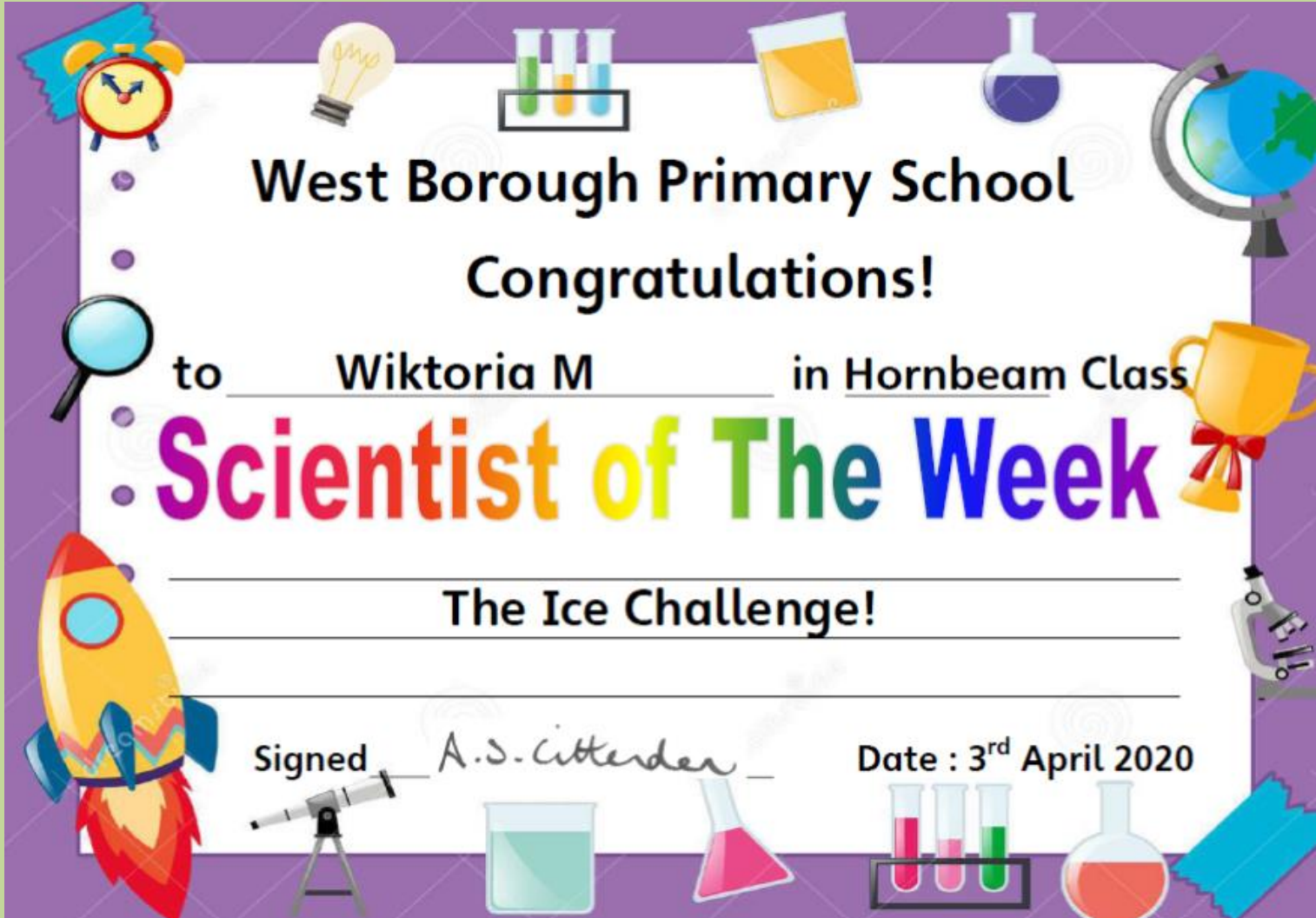

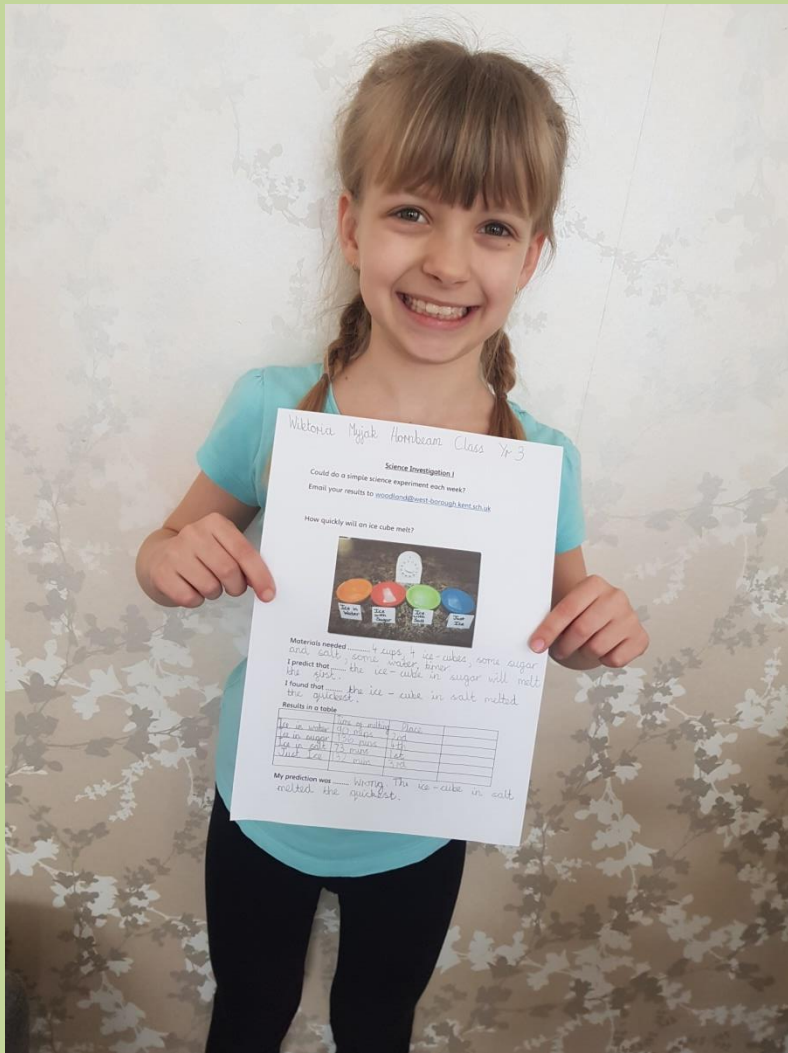

I predict that the ice-cube in sugar will melt the first.

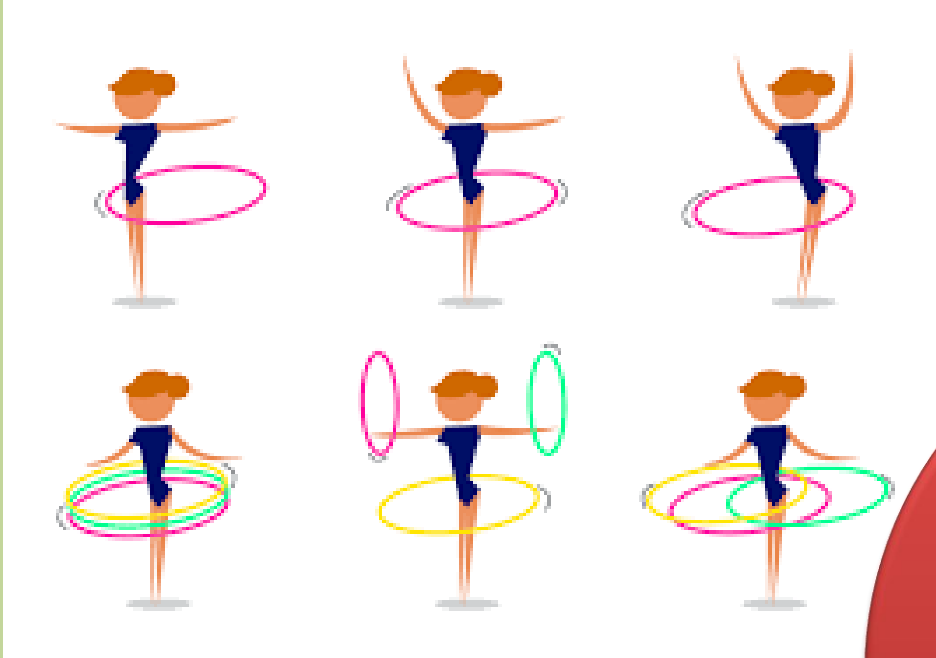
I found that the ice-cube in salt melted the quickest.

Results in a table

	Time of melting	Place
Ice in water	90 mins	2nd
Ice in sugar	136 mins	4th
Ice in salt	73 mins	1st
Just Ice	132 mins	3rd
