Maths

Topic - River Deep, Mountain High

This term our topic is River Deep, Mountain High and thinking of where in the World would we like to travel and why. We will locate the world's countries, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, and major cities. This week we are focussing on Mountains.

- Challenge 1 – Research facts about Mount Everest. Use the worksheet template to help you present your findings – or write in your exercise book.
- Challenge 2 – Research facts about Mount Kilimanjaro.
- Challenge 3- Write a glossary for 10 key words related to mountains. We have put some in to start you off.
- Challenge 4 – label the UK mountain ranges on the worksheet or just write the number and map out. If you want an extra task – you can build, design or draw a mountain range.
- Challenge 5 – Complete the crossword.

Have fun with your learning and remember we expect the same quality of learning and presentation for home learning as school learning. We look forward to seeing a copy of a piece of your learning this week!
