Maths

This week in maths we would like you to complete the following lessons:

English

- Lesson 4: Writing focus-make a new diary entry about your’ Bug Hotel.’ Make an information page about a mini-beast. Draw, label and write captions.
- Lesson 5: Writing focus-make a new diary entry about your’ Bug Hotel.’ Using your information page from yesterday make a description of your mini-beast using adjectives.
