

Year R Remote Learning – 27th April 2020

There are lots of activities to try this week but please don't feel that you have to get your child to do everything. Dip in and out as you wish.

On Monday, begin by reading or listening to one of the pirate stories that we have suggested. This will help to set the scene for the learning activities to be done this week.

Every day, there is 'Daily Learning Activity' which will be a mixture of writing, maths, colouring etc. This is like our 'Group Learning' activities that we do every day at school. For the activities on Wednesday and Friday, choose the activity whichever is most appropriate for your child. In addition, there are separate phonics and maths activities. The maths activities will progress throughout the week.

Phonics

Choose an activity that you feel your child will enjoy. Only do one each day (more if your child wants to) and take their lead. You will soon get to know how easy or difficult they are finding the activities. If you can't print them out, don't worry, as your child could read the words and match them by pointing to the word instead. They could have a go at writing the word too. The Power points are a more practical way to engage your child in phonics activities and might be all that your child wants to do. That is fine. They will still be learning!

Writing

Encourage your child to make marks using water and paintbrushes outside, or chunky chalks to make things fun. They could also make marks in sand, flour or shaving foam.

Playdough is also a great thing for your child to play with, as it strengthens their fingers as they are manipulating it. Here is a simple recipe (if you can get any flour!)

2 cups of flour
1 cup of salt
2 tablespoons of oil
2 cups of hot water
Food colouring (optional)

Put everything in a bowl and mix it all together. Your child will enjoy helping you to make this too.
