



Dear Parents / Carers,

This week's learning is based around 'What the Ladybird Heard.' Here is a link to the story, in case you don't have it at home.

On <u>Monday</u>, begin by reading or listening to the story. This will help to set the scene for the learning activities to be done this week.

Every day, there is a 'Daily Learning Activity' which will be a mixture of writing, maths, colouring etc. This is like our 'Group Learning' activities that we do every day at school. For the activities on <u>Tuesday</u>, choose which maths activity is most appropriate for your child. On <u>Wednesday</u>, watch the Power point about the life cycle of a ladybird before doing the activity.

In addition, there are separate phonics and maths activities to try each day. The maths activities will progress throughout the week and are all based around the story.

On <u>Friday</u>, there are some extra activities to celebrate VE day.

<u>Writing</u>

Keep trying to encourage your child to write using the cursive script and remind them to use a capital letter at the beginning of a sentence and a full-stop at the end.
