Maths

This week in maths we would like you to complete the following lessons:

- Lesson 1 – Multiply by 10
- Lesson 2 – Multiply by 100
- Lesson 3 – Divide by 10
- Lesson 4 – Divide by 100
- Lesson 5 – TTRS & Hit the Button

English

This week in English we are going to continue our focus on the text 'Amazing Aliens'. Please complete the following activities this week:

- Lesson 1: (Page 14 -15) Read the text, then complete the challenge on page 14 and activity on page 15.
- Lesson 2: (Page 16-17 – **only 'Explain' on p17**) Add more detail to your log by altering your sentences and using fronted adverbials. Then use 'because' to help explain your sentences.
- Lesson 3: (Page 17 – 'Write Away') Use your plan to write a draft of your log.
- Lesson 4: (Page 18-19) Imitate the advert and have a go at making your own. Then use Page 19 to plan your own ideas.
- Lesson 5: (Page 20) Write your advert, using your plan. Once you have checked your SPaG, publish your advert. You could include pictures, maps and quotes to make it even more exciting!
