Task 1:

Write character profiles for the three main characters, Rock, Paper and Scissors.

You could include:

Name, Age, Appearance, Background, Family, Friends, Enemies, Ambitions, Hopes and Dreams, Fears, Likes and Dislikes

Task 4:

Create a comic strip of the story. Include the main points as captions.

You could even make models of the characters and take photos of them for each scene/part of the story.

Be creative!

Task 5:

Create a Wanted poster for Scissors.

You may want to include:

A picture, details of the crimes he has committed, a physical description of the character, details of where he was last seen, reward/capture information.

Task 2:

Create a setting description for each character's home.

Think carefully about their characteristics and what kind of home would suit them. Remember, their home would probably not be a conventional house. Also, think about the surroundings of their home.



Task 6:

Choose one of the characters and write the story from their point of view.

Think about how to include important, descriptive details, creating tension during the fight scene and including the emotions of the characters.

Task 3:

Write the dialogue (conversation) between Rock and Paper when he tries to persuade her to come with him.

Choose one of the characters and write an 'Origins' story for them.

Where have they come from?

How were they created?

Why were they created?
