We are learning to (WALT): compare fire fighting from 1666 to present day

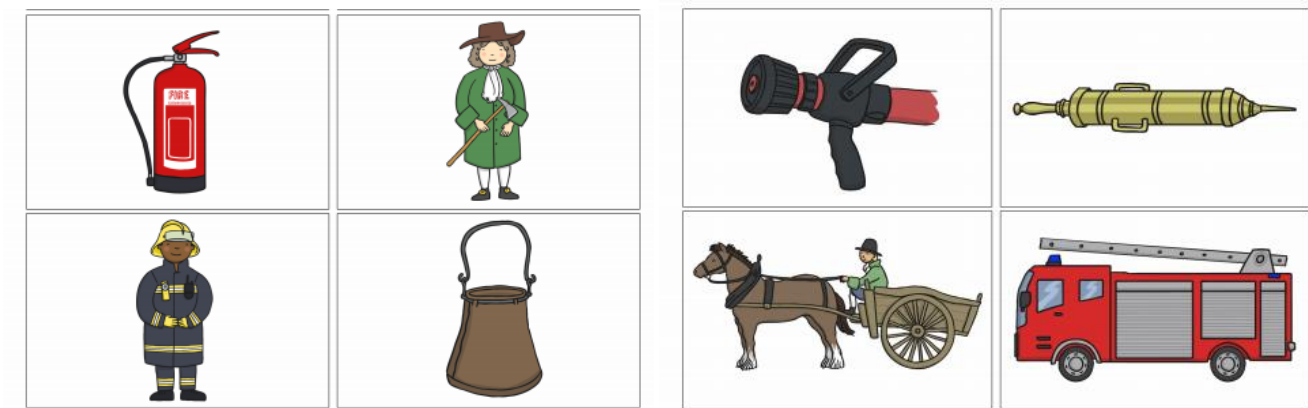
Read through the power point 'Fire fighters then and now'
