Try adding I more and I less to a given number and then add 2 more and 2 less. What is the total?




Add I more and draw the total.




The best way to do this activity is to use real objects – raisins, cheerios, socks, balls etc.

There are some spiders to cut out if you prefer to do it this way.




#### **Activity 4:**

Join the dots from I-10 or I-20 to make the spider's web. Your grown-up could write the numbers in your book instead of printing out the sheet.




#### **Activity 5:**




