

Year R Home Learning Activities – w/b 13th July 2020

Here are some activities for you to do at home. There are 5 phonics, maths and fun activities which you can spread over the week. Please continue to send us your lovely pictures for our class padlet.

Day 1:

Have a think about the time you have spent in school.

1. Complete the 'All about me' sheet. This is for you to bring back for your new teacher in September.
2. **Phonics** Sing the alphabet song, remembering to say each letter clearly. Recap all the phase 2 sounds that you have learnt.
3. **Maths** Start to learn to count in 2s to 20. Go up and down the stairs saying the numbers in order.

Day 3:

1. Write a list of all the things that you like to do, both at home and at school. You may want to tell this to your new teacher when you come into school to meet them.
2. **Phonics** Recap all the tricky words from Phase 2 & 3. How many times can you write each one in a minute?
3. **Maths** Go on a walk looking at house numbers. Can you spot the odd and even house numbers?



Day 4:

1. Look in a mirror and draw a self-portrait.
2. **Phonics** Use the tricky words and write some sentences.
3. **Maths** Using 2p coins count up to 20. Set up your toy shop again and pay for the toys only using 2p coins.



Day 2:

1. Draw or paint picture of your family.



2. **Phonics** Write the alphabet in both capital letters and lower case letters. Recap the Phase 3 sounds that you learnt.
3. **Maths** Can you write out the numbers (counting in 2s) up to 20. Can you see a pattern? Now write out all the numbers from 1-20. Can you tell which number is odd and which is even? How do you know if a number is odd or even?



Day 5:

1. Make a card for someone that you are missing. May be in your family or a friend from school.
2. **Phonics** Find a book or magazine. How many tricky words can you find? Can you find more than last time? Can you write them down?
3. **Maths** Make or find and play a match the pairs game.
