<u>Phonics</u>

Body percussion and rhythm:


• Musical statues with a twist! Play their favourite music. Ask them to clap and dance to the music listening to the beat, help children do this by modelling clapping the beat. When the music stops tell the children to strike a pose and freeze.

Rhyme:

 Read a simple rhyming book (or use nursery rhymes), once familiar with it pause just before you say the rhyming word to see if they can shout it out. Can even be a different word! E.g. Twinkle, twinkle little car.
