

## Year R Remote Learning Activities – w/b 21/9/20

Here are the activities that we will be doing at school this week. Encourage your child to do one activity each day, along with a phonics and maths activity which you can find on separate sheets.

### Activity 1:

We would like you to begin to recognise the numbers 0-10.

Write the numbers on pieces of paper. Show them to your child, ask them what the number is. Can they count out the correct number of objects for the number? Can you make a number line together?

### Activity 4:

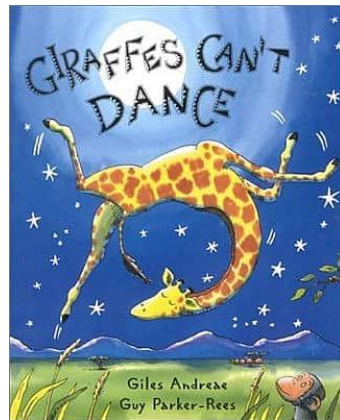
At school we are beginning to learn how to write letters but first of all we write and draw patterns. The first pattern is drawing dots.

Draw lots of dots in different colours on some paper.

### Activity 2:

In Reception we begin to teach the children about the 'Power of Yet.' This means that when a child says that they can't do something, we reply with, "You can't do it yet."

Talk to your child about things that they can do and things that they can't do **yet**. Ask them about something that they feel they need more practise with e.g. doing up their coat on their own, dressing themselves,



### Activity 3:

Look at pictures of the animals from the story. Draw, colour or paint some of the animals.

You could also recreate the animal's footprints in mud or flour.



### Activity 5:

Make some play doh and create your own animals.



#### Recipe

- 2 cups plain flour
- 2 tablespoons oil
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar (if you have some)
- 1 to 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right)
- food colouring (optional)
