a small group of **houses**, some with a few **shops**, that are often in the countryside. Barming is a **Village**.

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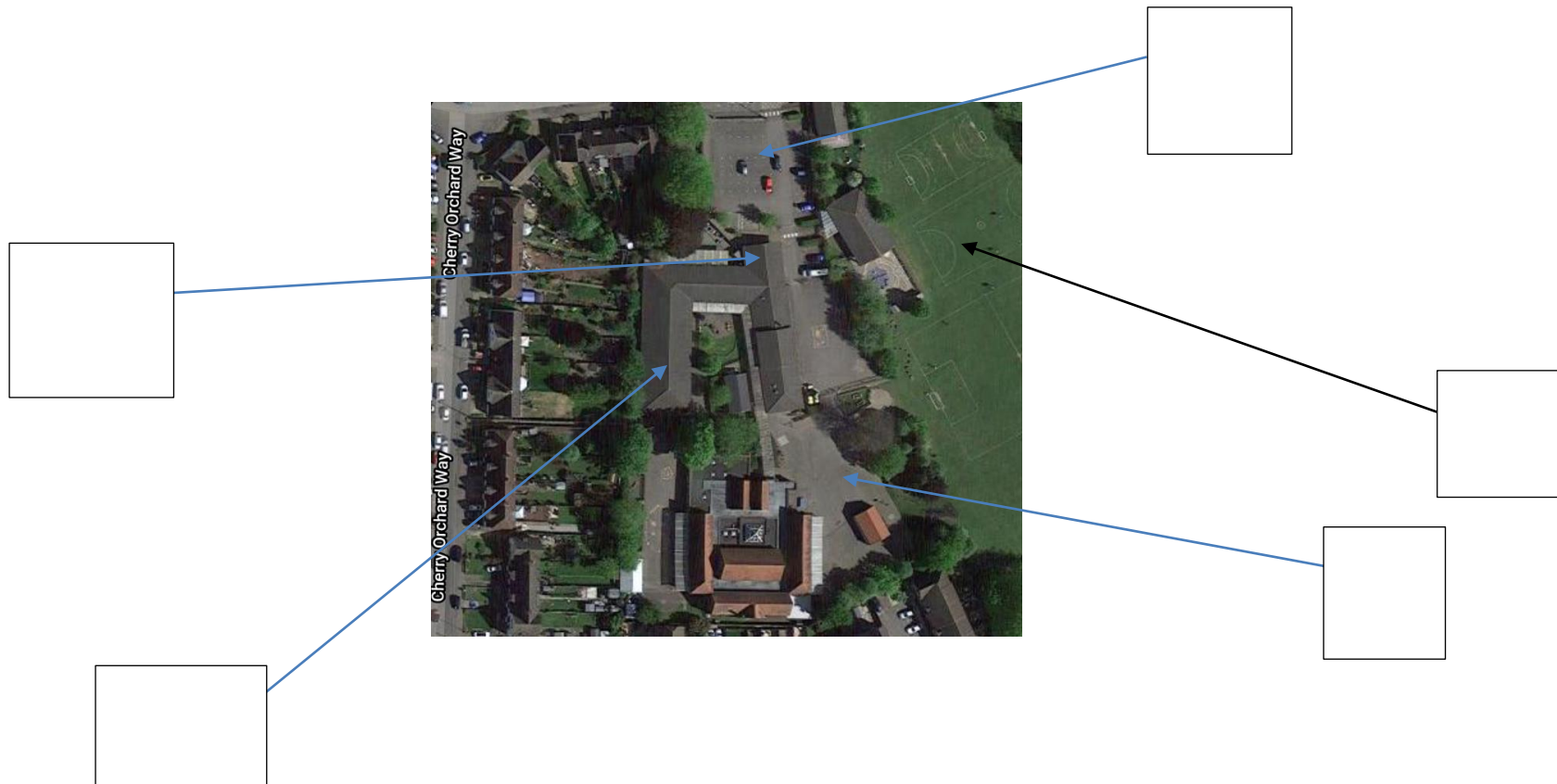
