


<u>English</u>

The focus of this week's English learning is to write a newspaper report and to use Word for Windows, Publisher or Google docs to publish your news story.

Please use Spelling Frame to help you learn your spellings.

Use a strategy to help you learn these words. For example mnemonic like *my lead was made out of lead* or Visual like drawing of a church tower as part of the word *altar*

Remember....
Write in the past tense

Write in the third person by using the pronouns he, she, him, her, it, they, their, them

Time conjunctions e.g. while, next, soon afterwards, without warning, earlier in the day, later, afterwards

After each paragraph read through your work.

Using last week's plan for the 5W questions write a lead paragraph. Look at newspapers to see how they start. Use the resource Fronted Adverbials to help you.

A lead paragraph is a summary of the main event. It gives the reader basic information about what has happened. Once you have written the lead use your plan on the main body of the report to write up the rest of your news story. Again have a read of newspapers and magpie ambitious word choices. Keep the tone formal, so don't use any contracted words unless it is part of the direct speech of an eye-witness or expert.

Challenge: up level vocabulary to make it more ambitious! (e.g. stated, exclaimed, terrified, described)	


