Year R Remote Learning Activities – w/b 5/10/20

Here are the activities that we will be doing at school this week. Encourage your child to do one activity each day, along with a phonics and maths activity which you can find on separate sheets.

Activity I:

Make your own hedgehog with play dough. If you don't have playdough, your child could draw a hedgehog and make its spikes out of leaves, or sticks. You could also draw the outline of a hedgehog and use a fork dipped in paint to print on the spikes.



Activity 4:

Phonics sorting

Find some objects or pictures that start with the phonemes that have been taught already – s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c

Ask your child to sort them into groups that all start with the same sound.

Activity 2:

In Reception we begin to teach the children how to draw and make patterns before we teach them how to correctly form the letters.

This week we are teaching how to draw spirals. Encourage your child to draw small spirals on paper or use chalks or a wet brush and draw great big spirals on the ground.



This week our theme is hedgehogs



Activity 3:

Play a pairs or matching game.
