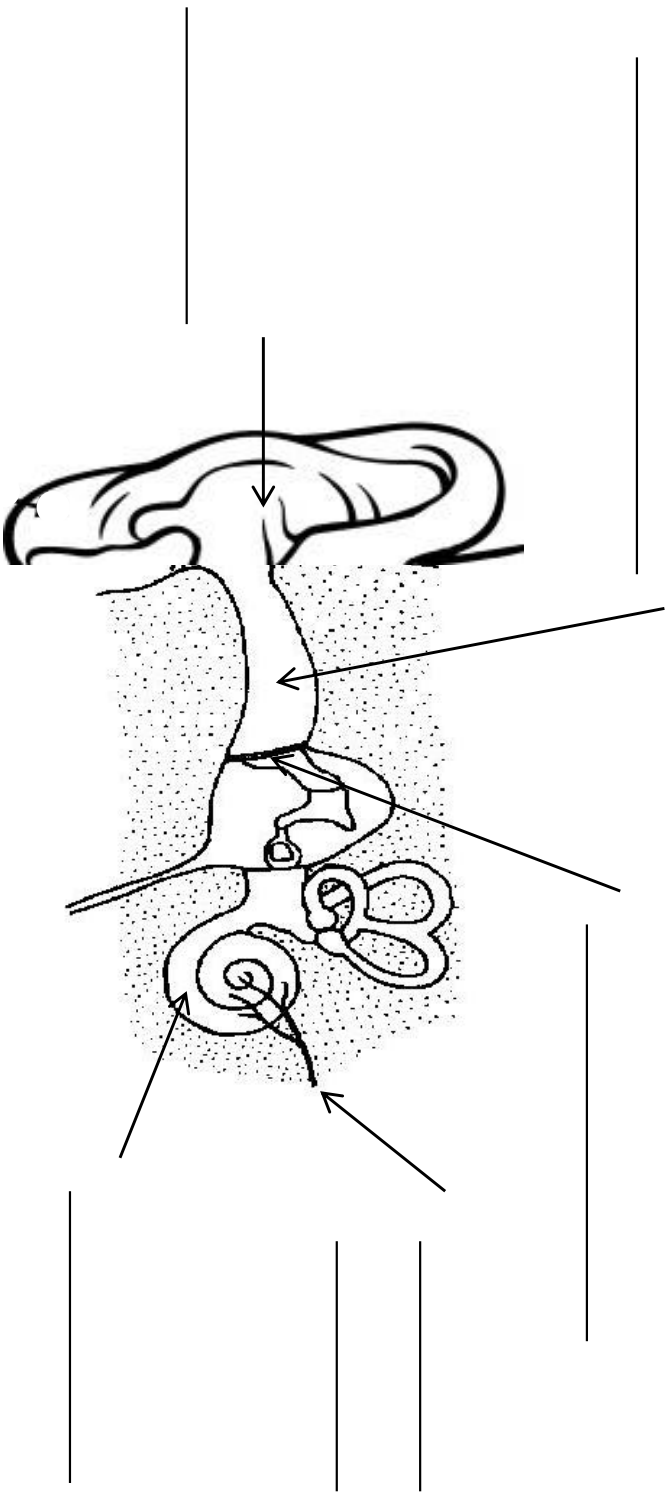

## **Know how we hear sounds**

*These statements about how we hear are jumbled up. You need to write them in the correct order.*

The vibrations pass along the auditory nerve to your brain.

Your brain sorts the message and you hear the sound.

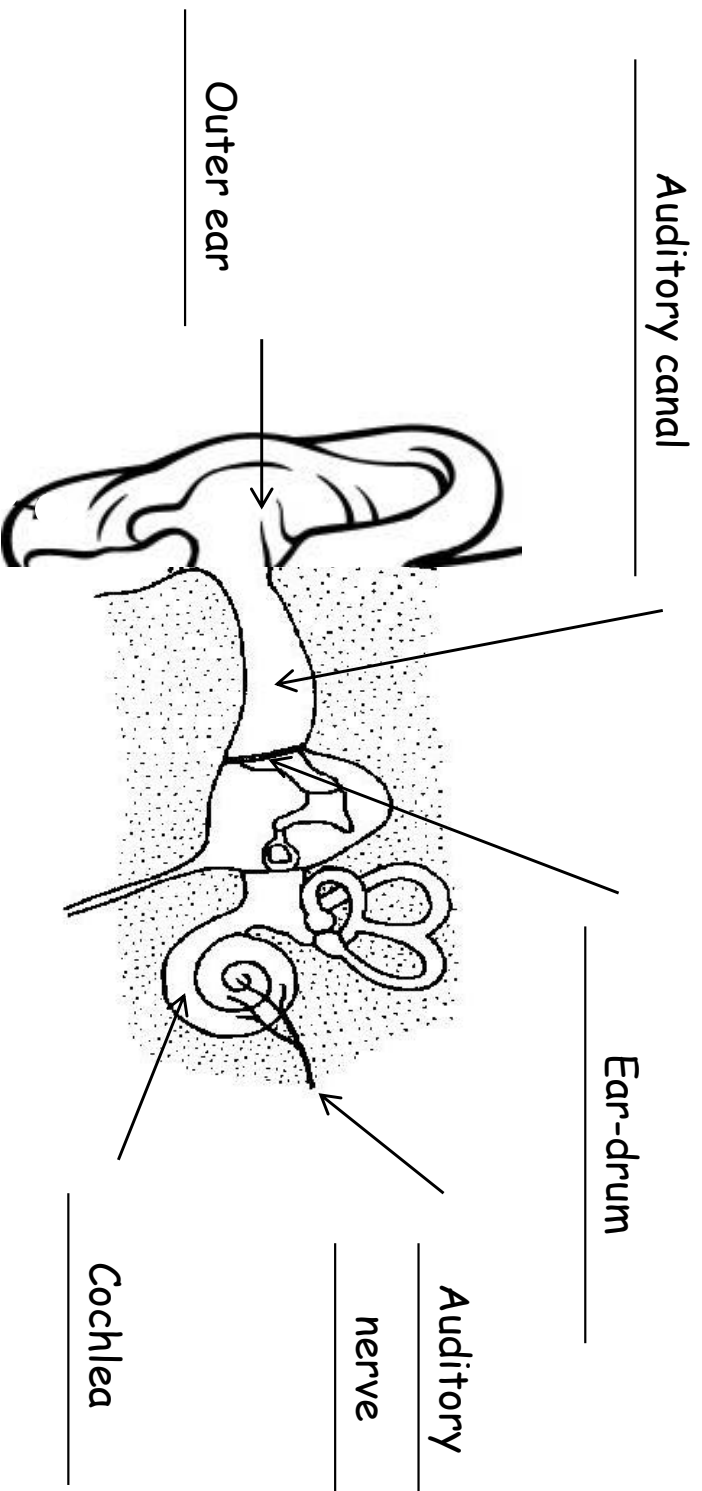
Your outer ear channels the sound waves into your ear.

## Answers

- 1) Your outer ear channels sound waves into your ear.
- 2) The sound waves travel along the auditory canal.
- 3) The ear-drum vibrates when a sound hit it
- 4) The vibrating ear-drum makes the little bones in your ear vibrate.
- 5) The vibrations pass along the auditory nerve your brain.
- 6) Your brain sorts the messages and you hear the sound.
