Here are the activities that we will be doing at school this week. Encourage your child to do one activity each day, along with a phonics and maths activity which you can find on separate sheets.

Activity 1:

Read the story 'After the Storm' by Nick Butterworth.

Draw a picture of what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

Activity 4:

Phonics – find the odd one out.

Have either objects or pictures of things starting with s,a,t,p,i,n

Put all the things beginning with 's' in a group and put on thing beginning with 'a' in the group. Which one is the odd one out?

Repeat this with each group of letters.

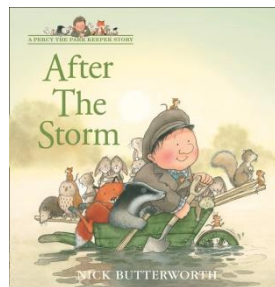
Activity 2:

You could draw a tree and put the crosses all over it in lots of different colours.

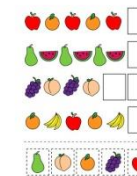


Activity 3:
