Fireworks!

This term we will be thinking about celebrations and asking the children to remember events they have celebrated.

At Nursery this week we are going to be thinking about Fireworks Night.

Outside we will be practicing dancing like fireworks, throwing and catching colourful scarves and building our own bonfires.

Praise listening skills:

Good listening.

Good looking- at the person.

Fingers still.

Lips closed.

Ears open.



Maths

We are going to be making firework rockets using 2D shapes:

- Triangle
- Rectangles

We will also talk about 3D shapes for making rockets:

- Cylinder
- Cone

Can they count down to blast off? Counting backwards is very tricky! To help we are going to sing - "10 little fireworks standing in a line, one zoomed off and then there were 9..."

We are going to look at fireworks events online and talk about safety.
