Dear parent/carers,

Unfortunately, due to Covid-19 and competing pressures we will not be measuring year 6 this academic year, we would encourage you to weigh and measure your own children. How to do this can be found here https://youtu.be/i8_mubVI6hk and then use www.nhs.uk/live-well/healthy-weight/bmi-calculator to identify if your child is underweight, a health weight, overweight or obese.

Parents often find it difficult to tell if their child is a healthy weight. Whatever their weight, it is important that children eat a healthy diet and are active every day to develop a healthy body.
