

Year I Learning Activities – week commencing 16th November

Monday

English and topic learning

We are celebrating old and new toys throughout this week.

Maths learning

Tuesday

English and topic learning

Watch the video from yesterday and draw your favourite old toy.

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in twos and back down.

Using objects show the following sums:

$$2+2= \quad 8-5= \quad 6+4=$$

$$7-1=$$

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together.

Wednesday

English and topic learning

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in twos and back down. Use a number line 0 to 10,

If needed using objects answer the following sums;

$$7+3= \quad 4-3= \quad 9+0=$$

$$10-5=$$

Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together.

Thursday

English and topic learning

Look for different toys in your home made from these different materials: plastic, wood, cotton or metal. How many do you have? Do you have any with more than one material?

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in twos and back down.

Answer the following sums;

$$3+1= \quad 9-8= \quad 9+1=$$

$$6+4=$$

Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together.

Practise forming numbers 0-10 correctly.
