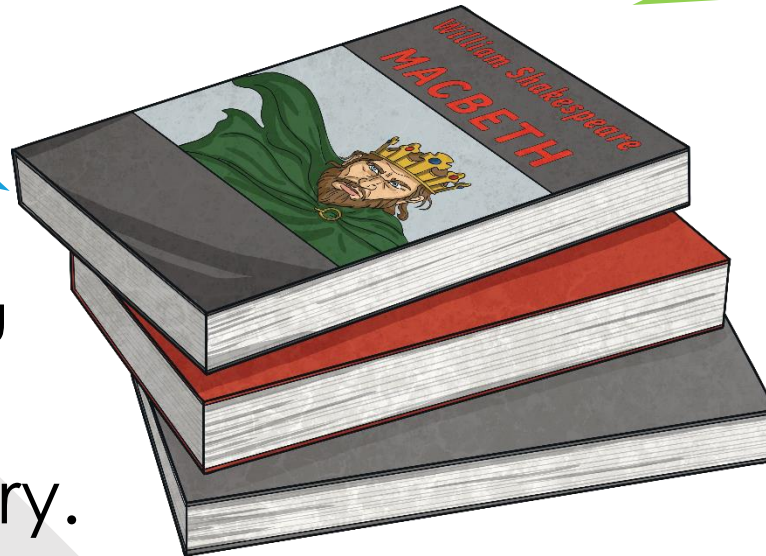
First person...
