- A verb is a doing word.

Tense – tells us when something happened.

When we use a verb we have to think about what **tense** to use. This tells us when the action took place.

For example – Regular Verbs...

- Yesterday I danced on the stage.
- I dance on the stage. / I am dancing on the stage.
- Next week I will dance on the stage.
