## Verbs – What is a verb?

- A verb is a doing word.
- A verb is an action word.
- A verb is something you can do.

When we use a verb we have to think about what **tense** to use. This tells us when the action took place.

For example – Regular Verbs...

- Yesterday I **danced** on the stage.
- I **dance** on the stage. / I **am dancing** on the stage.
- Next week I **will dance** on the stage.

Tense – tells us when something happened.

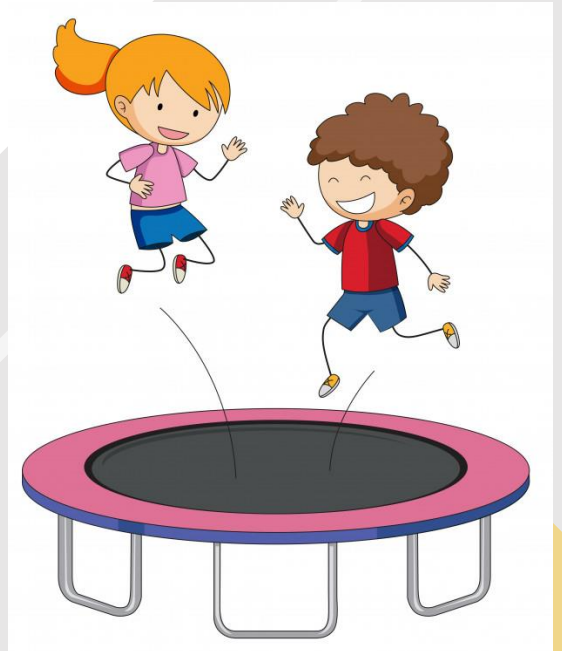
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## What are the children doing?

- Say a sentence to show the action happening now, use the **present tense**.
- Say a sentence to show the action happening in the future, use the **future tense**.
