

Nursery Learning Activities w/b 23rd November 2020 Nursery Rhymes

This term we will be thinking about celebrations and asking the children to remember events they have celebrated.

At Nursery this week we are celebrating Nursery Rhyme week!

Listen to a range of nursery rhymes or sing all your favourites! Nursery rhymes are lots of fun to share.

Some of our activities this week:

Recite the nursery rhyme 'Jack be Nimble' and substitute each child's name to jump over objects. Vary height and width (if possible) to gain experience and skill.

Challenge: candle on floor. Recite rhyme and substitute name and number of times e.g.

Billy be nimble

Billy be quick

Jump 3 times

over the candle stick

Recite the nursery rhyme 'Hickory Dickory Dock' a couple of times then see if children can join in. Recite the rhyme again but leave out the last word - children to fill in the missing word. Reinforce the rhyming pairs in the poem by clapping on the end word.

Maths ideas - talk about the words up and down, use actions to describe and show the mouse running up and down. Talk about the numbers 1 - 12 as you show them clocks.

Use or make puppets to act out the nursery rhymes for the family to enjoy!
