It's beginning to look a lot like
Christmas!

This term we will be thinking about celebrations and asking the children to remember events they have celebrated. At Nursery this week we are beginning to think about Christmas!



Maths:

Show a set of presents that Santa has prepared, ready to deliver to a house. Explain that there has been a mix up and there are actually two children living there. How many presents will Santa need for both of them? Discuss ways of finding the answer and model using cubes or more parcels. Ask the children to help Santa work out what double other amounts of presents would be. The children could compare their toys talking about big/small and putting them in size order.



Phonics: - Mystery Bag:

Sounds like.... Fill a bag with some objects for the children to pull out one by one, when someone pulls something out, everyone needs to try to think of something else that starts with that sound.

Use Class Dojo or email to show us the fantastic and imaginative games your child is playing at home.
