

Year I Learning Activities – week commencing 7th December

Monday

English and topic learning

This week in English we are rewriting the story Lost in the Toy Musuem. Each section should only be 4-5 sentences. Remind yourself of our story Lost in the Toy Museum by watching the following:

With an adult talk through the story and write a word map of words to help you with writing. For example; Bunting, museum, hide-and-seek etc

Maths learning

This week in maths we are focusing on numbers to 20. Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos forwards and backwards. Write numbers 0-20 in order, do you notice a pattern? Can you spot any numbers in your home? [Numbers in the Teens \(They Start with a 1\) \(song for kids about teen numbers\) - YouTube](#)

Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practice one armed robot letters

Tuesday

English and topic learning

Write the first part of the story. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. When you have finished try to read what you have written to an adult.

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos forwards and backwards. Write numbers 0-20 on small pieces of paper if possible, to create number cards. Select a number card, say the number and count out the correct amount of objects.

Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practise your dancing moves through watching the below Supermovers

Wednesday

English and topic learning

Write the middle part of the story. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. When you have finished try to read what you have written to an adult.

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos forwards and backwards. Count out 10 objects, add one more, how many are there now? Write the number. Keep adding one more until there are 20 objects.

Challenge write numbers in words.

Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together.

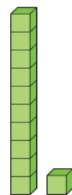
Thursday

English and topic learning

Write the last part of the story. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. When you have finished try to read what you have written to an adult.

Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos forwards and backwards. Represent numbers 11-20 by drawing the tens and ones. E.g. 11- 1 ten, 1 one (see picture)



Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practise forming numbers 0-10 correctly. Challenge try to spell the words from zero to ten.



Friday

English and topic learning-

Maths learning

Practise number bonds to 10.
