

# Year 1 Learning Activities – week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> December

## Monday

### English and topic learning

In RE this week we are learning the Christmas story. Watch the following link and talk to an adult about the story.

### Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos and back down. This week in maths we are learning about one more and one less than numbers to 20. Choose a number between 1-20. Count out that many objects and then add one more. How many have you got now? Repeat with different numbers.

### Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practice one armed robot letters

*r, m, n, h, b, k, p*

## Tuesday

### English and topic learning

Watch the story again. Choose a section from the story and draw and label the picture.

### Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos and back down. Write one more than numbers up to 20. E.g. one more than 15 is 16. You could write it as a number sentence  $15+1=16$ .

### Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practise your dancing moves through watching the below Supermovers

## Wednesday

### English and topic learning

Watch the story again and rewrite the start of the story. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

### Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos and back down. Choose a number between 1-20. Count out that many objects and then take one away to find one less. How many have you got now? Repeat with different numbers.

### Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together.

## Thursday

### English and topic learning

Watch the story again and rewrite the middle and end of the story. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

### Maths learning

Practise counting from 0 to 20 in ones and twos and back down. Write one less than numbers up to 20. E.g. one less than 15 is 14. You could write it as a number sentence  $15-1=14$ .

### Daily challenge

Read a story to an adult for at least 10 minutes using phonics to sound out and blend words together. Practise forming numbers 0-10 correctly. Challenge try to spell the words from zero to ten.



## Friday

### English and topic learning-

Make some Christmas Art. Could you make a Christmas card for someone special? Could you use recycled materials to create a Christmas decoration?

### Maths learning

Practise number bonds to 10.
