

Year 5 Remote Learning – Week Beginning 14th December 2020


Please make sure you are reading every day and practising times tables.

Each arm has six claws and each foot has seven toes. A Quadralix also has five eyes.● Talk to your maths buddy and work out:<ul style="list-style-type: none">– How many arms do two Quadralix have?– How many eyes do four Quadralix have?– How many toes do two Quadralix have?– How many claws does one Quadralix have?<p>NOW TRY THIS</p><p>Invent your own maths monster with different features.
