### Maths Counting

Look around the house for objects to count; this could be baubles on the tree, leaves from outside, toys, books etc.

Point at each object as you count. Put out a group of objects, what would 1 more be? Count to check.



### Phonics

Rehearse the rhyme with the actions (rotating hand over hand as in the song 'Wind the bobbin up'). "Ro ... ly ... po ... ly ... ever ... so ... slowly Ro ... ly ... poly faster." (Increase the speed of the action as you increase the speed of the rhyme.)

Now add in new verses, such as: "Stamp ... your ... feet ... ever ... so ... slowly. Stamp ... your feet faster." Suggest sounds and movements to be incorporated into the song. E.g. "Say hello ever so quietly. Say HELLO LOUDER!"
