We've yet to know what January may bring (with much speculation already in the media!) but please be assured we will contact you before the start of term with any updated guidance or risk assessments.


One final plea from me. As stated in Friday's letter, please do contact us over the holiday period should anyone in your household:

Pregnant? Children/child under 4?

You qualify for Healthy Start if you're at least 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under four years old and you or your family get at least one of the following:

- Income support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (with a family income of £16,190 or less per year)
- Universal Credit (with a family take-home pay of £408 or less per month)
