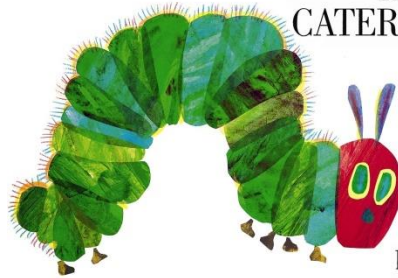
The Very Hungry Caterpillar

This week we will be reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.

Maths

Use strips of paper to make your own caterpillars of different lengths. Talk about how they are different. Use words such as longer and shorter. Can they order the caterpillars from shortest to tallest?

The caterpillar eats lots of food:
Find 1-----, 2-----, 3----- - they can pick the food (as long as the grown-ups are happy for it to be used, or you could use pretend objects!)

We will be learning how to write the numbers 1 -5. This is challenging but the children are superstars!



Over the next two weeks there will be daily 'Check-in' and story time. You will receive Zoom links. The link will always be the same.

Understanding the World – We will begin to look at healthy foods and why our bodies need fruit and vegetables. Can they children talk about their food likes and dislikes? What would they eat if they were the caterpillar? They could draw their favourite foods to share with the rest of the class.
