After joining in with today's phonics video, we would like you to write some words using the new phoneme that we have learnt today **'ai.'**

You will need a whiteboard pen and whiteboard or pen and paper to do this activity. These are the words that we would like you to write;

rain, sail, tail, wait, pain

Remember that they all have the same digraph in them **'ai'**. Can you think of any other words that say **'ai.'**

Daily Learning Activity

Today, we would like you to write some sentences to go with the story. For example; **"Zog is on a log."** **"Zog is big."** **"Zog can jump."** Draw a picture to go with your sentences and remember to use your phonic knowledge to help you to spell the words!



Maths Activity

This week, our maths activities are based around numbers up to 5. It is really important that your child understands the order of the numbers and can count forwards and backwards, including 0. Once you have joined in with the activities on the video, try the following activities together:

Provide examples contrasting familiar numbers with 0 to support the children's understanding that 0 represents the absence of something. Use the following pictures to help



How many apples are on each tree? Which tree shows zero?



How many people are on each bus? Which bus has zero passengers?



Which field has 0 horses? Which field has the most horses?
